Academic Achievements:

The tradition of securing 100% results in class X continues since the first batch till this year.

As many as 16 students secured grade A1 in Std. X CBSE exam.

A total of 32 students of our class XII passed with good percentages and have enrolled into professional courses in reputed institutions. Our school 1st topper Mas. Arya Ainchwar and second topper Miss Nancy Ramteke are being awarded with Shri SurajMal ji Chandak Smrithi Puraskar and Shri Janardan Ji Kancharlawar Smriti Puraskar by our Management Members.

Participation in the Cyber, Science, Maths and English Olympiads , itself is the biggest competition where a student competes to outshine others. It infuses a healthy competitive spirit through reward-based assessment. We motivate our students to take part in at least two of these Olympiad exams every year.

Our students have shown outstanding performance in the Olympiad examinations conducted by SOF and bagged gold , silver and bronze medals and few qualified for 2nd level exam whereas some of them even got gold medals for excellence . Mas Tejas Uttarwar secured International 1st rank in both Maths and Science Olympiads.

Literary and cultural activities

Keeping this thought in mind we conduct various competitions to foster the literary and cultural talents of the students. I would now like to read out the details of the same.

- Yoga is an ancient form of exercise to develop the mind and soul and strengthens our body too. We started our co-curricular activities with the celebration of International Yoga Day which was celebrated on 21st June
- We had extempore competition on 24th June.. The objective of the competition is to make the students confident and better orators so that they can express their views on any topics.
- We celebrated Gurupoornima with reverence for Guru Maharishi Mahesh Yogi who is our inspiration on 3rd July 2023. There was a special assembly dedicated to the teachers, the Gurus, with 'Gurupujan' and 'Guru Bhajan'.
- Our tiny tots of Nursery were welcomed for their first day of their school on Gurupurnima day with a traditional Vidyarambham ceremony. To perform this ceremony, parents along with their kids were invited. To make this day remarkable, parents were asked to trace 'Om' pattern in the raw rice grain plate holding the hand of their child. Also, the palm printing activity was conducted for the kids and the parents as a memory of the first day of the child's school.
- To inculcate value of leadership, commitment and responsibility among students and to provide them opportunity to experience working as a member of School Cabinet Members, investiture ceremony was organised. Every year this ceremony is celebrated on school's foundation day which is 10th July.
- The new cabinet was invested with duties for academic session 2023-24. Mas. Siddhant Ambekar and Miss. Rutuja Rewatkar were bestowed as Head Boy and Head Girl respectively.
- National reading month was organized from 19th June to 18th July in school and different activities were conducted for different classes to promote and develop reading skills among the children. School students also visited ZP school in Datala village and made the students aware of benefits of reading.
- The school organized a tree plantation drive on 26 July, on account of 'Tree Plantation Day' under the CBSE program- 'One Child One Plant'. The ECO Club members along with the Management Members, Principal and the Vice-Principal participated the event.

- Organising Shobha Yatra on Janmashtami is tradition of our school. This year too a grand shobha yatra was organized wherein staff, students and management members participated with great enthusiasm.
